The Box Hollower is just one of the many unique woodturning tools from Robert Sorby.

Other special products include:

Mushroom tool (Ref: 804H)

The same unique design as the Box Hollower but with a shorter shaft and smaller handle as the Captive Ring Tool. This allows for more delicate projects to be produced and is fitted with a Mushroom cutter for undercut hollowing such as the underneath of mushroom caps.

Unique cutters

All the cutters for the Mushroom Tool, the Box Hollower and the Captive Ring Tool are interchangeable, together with many more cutters available seperately, unique to these three tools.

Stebcentre

The ultimate woodturners spindle turning drive centre. The Stebcentre has razor sharp serrated teeth for extreme grip on the work piece. It has a stainless steel spring loaded centre pin that allows for differing amounts of pressure to be applied to the workpiece. This unique centre pin design is useful to both the beginner as well as the professional. It is available in 1MT and 2 MT with head sizes of 1/2" (13mm) 7/8" (22mm) and 1 1/4" (32mm) and for larger lathes there is also a 3MT version of the 1 1/4" (32mm).

Steb Drive

The Steb Drive is also available with the same sized heads as the standard version but with a specially design body to fit into the jaws of most 4 jaw scroll chucks.

Revolving (Live) Stebcentre

As a compliment to the Stebcentre in the headstock there is also a revovling or live centre version. Not only does this exert an even more secure grip, it also allows the turner to produce basic off-centre work with complete confidence. Available with 1/2" (13mm) 7/8" (22mm) and 1 1/4" (32mm) head and in 1MT or 2MT.

Hardwood scraper (Ref: 821H) Micro (Ref: 860H)

A scraper specifically developed for harder woods such as African Blackwood where a standard scraper would tear the grain giving a rough finish. Due to its design the Hardwood scraper produces a perfect smooth finish everytime.
